### 2011 Chardonnay Martinelli Vineyard Russian River

- Double Gold Medal - San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition - Gold Medal & 96 Points - 2013 North Coast Wine Challenge Best of the Best

Exotic citrus aromas echo of pineapple, apricot, kiwi and orange peel. On the palate there is an awesome display of minerality and crisp, citrus, green apple finishing with lemon zest. The texture is exceptional with sweet vanilla framing a lingering, long finish. \$40/bottle



# 2010 Magnolia Series Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley

Gold Medal - San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition

Blackberry, currants, and leather impressions are found in the nose. A dry, smoky, chalky texture is laced with blackcurrant, plum, white pepper, and balanced but firm tannin that leave a soft, velvety finish. \$25/bottle



## 2011 Pinot Noir Soberanes Vineyard Santa Lucia

Silver Medal - San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition

Bright and forceful Bing cherries and dark berries along with the slightest hue of roasted coffee bean on the nose. Immediate and broad textured tannins cover the palate as flavors of black raspberries; licorice and black tea leaves unravel. Oak-inspired overtones of crispy charred marshmallows and fall spice with balance acids elongate a finish that reverbs for hours. \$45/bottle



#### 2012 Zinfandel Napa Valley

Silver Medal - San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition

Spicy raspberry and brambleberry immediately jump out of the glass as aromatics. Sweet cherry pie is framed nicely by a brushy and savory cedar plank. \$25/bottle



#### 2011 Pinot Noir Akins Vineyard Anderson Valley

Bronze Medal - San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition

Earthy, herbal, spicy, balanced. Inviting aromas of raspberry, cheery and cranberry. The entry offers an intriguing hint of strawberry and pomegranate with a whisk of green tea and spruce needle. On the finish, oak-inspired overtones of coffee and baking spice mingle with balance acids and fruit bringing this wine to a textured finish. \$35/bottle



#### 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon 'Stagecoach Vineyard' Napa Valley

- Bronze Medal San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition
- 92 Points Wine Enthusiast

Beautiful deep purple hues and complex aromas of black cherry, licorice and tobacco leaf. Medium-plus weight leads to a beautifully structured and layered mid-palate. The flavors consist of blackberry with hints of roasted coffee bean and earthy black tea. \$65/bottle
