

## Krutz 2011 "Martinelli Road" Chardonnay, Russian River Valley

Winemaker's Tasting Notes Bright and light golden-yellow in color.

Exotic and sweet vanilla bean aromatics backed by pear and kiwi with a slight orange peel. The palate resonates with texture and depth with minerality to match. Flavors of roasted plantains, red delicious apple, and lime frame the wine for a long yet soft finish.

Vineyard Planted in the early 90's, this is the coolest

vineyard site in the Russian River Valley, located at Lee Martinelli Sr.'s home ranch in Forestville, CA. After riding around with Lee in his pick-up truck when we visited his Woolsey Road, Zio Tony, and River Road Vineyards, he decided to take me to this gem.
