## **Krutz Magnolia Series 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley**

*Winemaker's Tasting Notes* Blackberry, currants, and leather impressions are found in the nose. A dry, smoky, chalky texture is laced with blackcurrant, plum, white pepper, and balanced but firm tannin that leave a soft, velvety finish.
