

Krutz 2015 Akins Vineyard Pinot Noir, Anderson Valley

Winemaker's Tasting Notes The 2015 Vintage was the warmest and earliest to date. Fortunately, temperatures moderated somewhat at harvest time allowing us to pick at optimal ripeness. It has flavors of dark black cherry, ripe red plums, and cinnamon. This Pinot Noir is round and full on the palate with velvety tannins. The bright acidity focuses the fruit punctuating the long and complex finish.
