Plush and velvet texture on the palate accompany flavors of dark fruit, cedar spice, forest floor and a bit of mountain sage. Youthful and lovely now and could easily negotiate 10+ more years.

Vineyard	Stagecoach Vineyard has become one of the most renowned vineyards in Napa Valley. It rises from 1,200 feet above sea level to nearly 1,850 feet at its highest on the southern side of the Oakville appellation's Pritchard Hill and Atlas Peak. With south-facing slopes filled with shallow, volcanic soils, its rugged terroir is ideal for growing intense cabernet sauvignon.
