

Krutz 2014 "Akins Vineyard" Pinot Noir, Anderson Valley

Winemaker's Tasting Notes The nose offers layers of red fruit, especially

sweet cherry and strawberry, mixed with earthy and spicy tones. Bright acidity and mild tannins frame the cherry-vanilla flavors on the early and the mid palate. The red fruit continues through the finish and is joined by floral notes and

spice.

Vineyards The Akins Family Vineyard is located a bit

closer to the coast just west near Philo on Highway 128. This vineyard is planted with some of the newer identified Dijon clones of

115, 777, and 667.
