Winemaker's Tasting Notes Stunning aromas of Boysenberry, blackberry jam, and mountain sage jump out of the glass. Blackcurrant, mint jam, and dark cherry dance on the palate framed by a cedar spice box. Balanced but firm dusty tannins leave a soft, clean and velvety finish.
