The 2016 Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir offers aromas of dried cherry, raspberry, and pomegranate. It is light to medium-bodied, with moderate concentration and fine tannin with hints of oak. It's an elegant Pinot Noir that displays the complex subtlety of the Sonoma Coast AVA.
