

## 2019 Rosé of Pinot Noir, Santa Lucia Highlands

## Winemaker's Tasting Notes

Bright and vibrant red fruit characteristics of strawberry and cherry are found on the nose. The soft and approachable mouthfeel from the neutral oak fermentation is balanced by a refreshing acidity as notes of strawberry and peach flavors help guide the wine.
