## 2006 "Stagecoach Vineyard" Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyard	In recent years, Stagecoach Vineyard has become one of the most renowned vineyards in Napa Valley. It rises 900 feet above sea level and continues to climb to nearly 1,850 feet at its highest elevations on the southern side of the Oakville appellation's Pritchard Hill. Blessed with south-facing slopes filled with shallow, volcanic soils, the site's rugged terroir is ideal for growing intensely colored Cabernet Sauvignon.

Winemaker's Tasting Notes	From its dense, saturated ruby hue to its earthy, cigar box nose, this Cab commands attention. Pure, focused flavors of black cherry, currant and tobacco while a mid palate of cedar spice vanilla and mocha linger in layers. All while framed with velvet like dusty tannins.
