Winemaker's Tasting Notes Pale yellow in color, our Magnolia Series Chardonnay exhibits powerful aromas of tropical fruits, specifically banana, as well as pear. This wine is made to be bright and refreshing. A medium-bodied wine gives way to a green apple and melon flavors and finish. Enjoy with seafood and salads!

<i>Vineyard</i>	The Sonoma Valley is heavily influenced by the Carneros weather, which cools down the region. Summer days are warm with cool nights and winters are mild. As a result, grapes stay on the vine longer, reaching high acidity and full flavor development.
