## Krutz 2010 Stagecoach Vineyard Syrah, Napa Valley

*Winemaker's Tasting Notes*      Bright and focused aromatics of slightly tart blueberries, red cherry and fresh ground coffee beans. Stunning flavors of blackberry and blueberry liqueur, but with an earthy texture. Medium- to full-bodied on the palate with savory spices delicately integrated tannins for a long and 'older' world style and finish.

### VINEYARD & HARVEST INFORMATION

<i>Vineyard</i>	Stagecoach Vineyard is one of the most renowned vineyards in Napa Valley. It rises 1,200 feet above sea level and continues to climb to nearly 1,850 feet at its highest elevations on the southern side of the Oakville appellation's Pritchard Hill and Atlas Peak. Blessed with south-facing slopes filled with shallow, volcanic soils, the site's rugged terroir is ideal for growing intense syrah. Viognier from the Ripken Vineyard.
