

## 2016 Pinot Noir Soberanes Vineyard Santa Lucia Highlands

Winemaker's Tasting Notes Fragrant, floral, and spicy: the aromas of this Soberanes Pinot Noir seem to leap from the glass. Dark red in color, the wine offers notes of rose petal, lavender, and a blend of cherry and wild strawberry on the nose. Its rich palate is replete with soft, velvety tannins that conclude with a subtle, many-layered finish. We're especially proud of the balance between the phenolic maturity of this wine's tannins and its aromatic finesse.

Vineyard Located next to Gary's Vineyard in the Santa Lucia Highlands, the Soberanes
