



2023 Cabernet Sauvignon, Beckstoffer Vineyard Georges III

Winemaker's Tasting Notes

Sourced from the historic Beckstoffer Georges III Vineyard, this Cabernet Sauvignon reveals layered aromas of dark fruit, led by ripe blackcurrants and plums, with a savory complexity and a strong sense of place. Full bodied and beautifully structured, the palate shows well integrated tannins balanced by fresh acidity, leading to a long, polished finish with a clean mineral edge.

VINEYARD & HARVEST INFORMATION

Vineyard	Georges III Vineyard is one of the oldest and most storied vineyards in all of Napa Valley. Planted in 1895 by Mrs. Thomas Rutherford, the 300- acre parcel was first purchased by Georges de Latour in 1928. It was the home of the great Rutherford Cabernets made by the famous Andre Tchelistcheff for Beaulieu Winery. Since 1988 the vineyard has been owned by the Beckstoffer Family.
