

2015 Pinot Noir Soberanes Vineyard Santa Lucia Highlands

Winemaker's Tasting Notes Brick red hue. This Pinot Noir showcases a lovely array of spice, fruit, and floral

notes. Initially on the nose, there are notes of cloves, cinnamon, ripe red cherry, ripe cranberry, and ripe pomegranate. After breathing, elements of strawberry, raspberry, violets, and jasmine unite around the hedonistic aroma profile. While the aromas are confirmed on the palate, there is broadening towards red fruit, spice, and floral tones, all in unison. The wine is silky smooth and lush on the

palate yet offers some bright acidity which frames its freshness.
