## 2016 Rosé of Pinot Noir, Santa Lucia Highlands

*Winemaker's Tasting Notes*      Bright and vibrant red fruit characteristics of strawberry and cherry are found on the nose. The soft and approachable mouthfeel from the neutral oak fermentation is balanced by a refreshing acidity as notes of strawberry and peach flavors help guide the wine.

*Vineyards*      Located next to Gary's Vineyard in the Santa Lucia Highlands, the Soberanes Vineyard is a joint venture between the Pisoni and Francioni Families. The site features tightly spaced vines and is planted to 33 acres of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Syrah. The vines features over a dozen of the most renowned heritage selections from California and Burgundy in pursuit of the finest wine quality.
