Winemaker’s Tasting Notes Focused aromatics of blueberries and blackberries with a hint of black pepper in the background. Characteristics of lush raspberries and blueberries can be found on the front palate with touches of smoked bacon, black pepper and spice coming towards the finish.

VINEYARD & HARVEST INFORMATION

<i>Vineyard</i>	Stagecoach Vineyard is one of the most renowned vineyards in Napa Valley. It rises 1,200 feet above sea level and continues to climb to nearly 1,850 feet at its highest elevations on the southern side of the Oakville appellation’s Pritchard Hill and Atlas Peak. Blessed with south-facing slopes filled with shallow, volcanic soils, the site’s rugged terroir is great for growing Syrah.
