Winemaker's Tasting Notes Pale, transparent, light yellow in color.

Aromatics scream of bright, crisp, citrus, lime, pineapple, and kumquat. The palate confirms the aromatics along with green apple and spicy lemon zest. This wine is held together with bright acid with the perfect amount of body and structure from neutral cooperage. Built to enjoy in its youth.

VINEYARD & HARVEST INFORMATION

Vineyard Jon & Barbara Phillips cultivate 6 acres of

Chardonnay at their estate located on the east side of Olivet Road in the Russian River Valley. The vineyard enjoys warm days followed by cool nights, which naturally develops and maintains great acidity in grapes. This is the first vintage we have worked with from this vineyard, and it is certainly on pace to become the main source

for our Magnolia Series Chardonnay.
