Winemaker's Tasting Notes

The 2022 Soberanes Pinot Noir is a beautiful representative of one of the premier vineyards in the Santa Lucia Highlands. It is velvety smooth in texture with a nose and palate of cherry cola and red rose petals with an underlying French oak influence from the barrel aging. Rich and inviting, the wine is solid through the finish.

Vineyard Located next to Gary's Vineyard in the Santa Lucia Highlands, the Soberanes Vineyard is a joint venture between the Pisoni and Franscioni Families. The site features tightly spaced vines and is planted to 33 acres of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Syrah. The Pisoni Clone (LaTâche) is the exclusive Pinot Noir clone selection for this vineyard.
