

2020 Sauvignon Blanc, Beckstoffer Melrose Vineyard

Winemaker's Tasting Notes

Brightly acidic and bursting with tropical aromatics of stone fruit. This unfiltered approach, along with 100% new French oak and no malolactic fermentation, gives way to a crisp but textured and long finish on the palate. Flavors of honeydew melon, white peach and a touch of lime all are found woven through this rare, old vine Sauvignon Blanc.
