## Magnolia Series 2011 Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley

*Winemaker's Tasting Notes* Aromatics of Boysenberry, blueberry jam, and mountain sage jump out of the glass. Blackberry, mint jam, and dark cherry confirm aromatics on the palate framed by a cedar spice box. Balanced but firm tannins leave a soft, and earthy finish.
